S.A.'s Major Dorothy Berry started working with addicts in about 1946 and was friends with Carlsen & Lopez

Before AA was formed a Father Dowling walked around the lake with Bill W. and shared the spiritual ~~precepts~~ ^{precepts} of Christian Theology entitled; St. Bernard's 12 steps to Humility; The Steps of St. Ignasius of Loyola, 12 steps to Aesthetics (PRAYER and these were to become the Steps of the Oxford/AA groups. ^{The traditions of AA were written in 1955}
