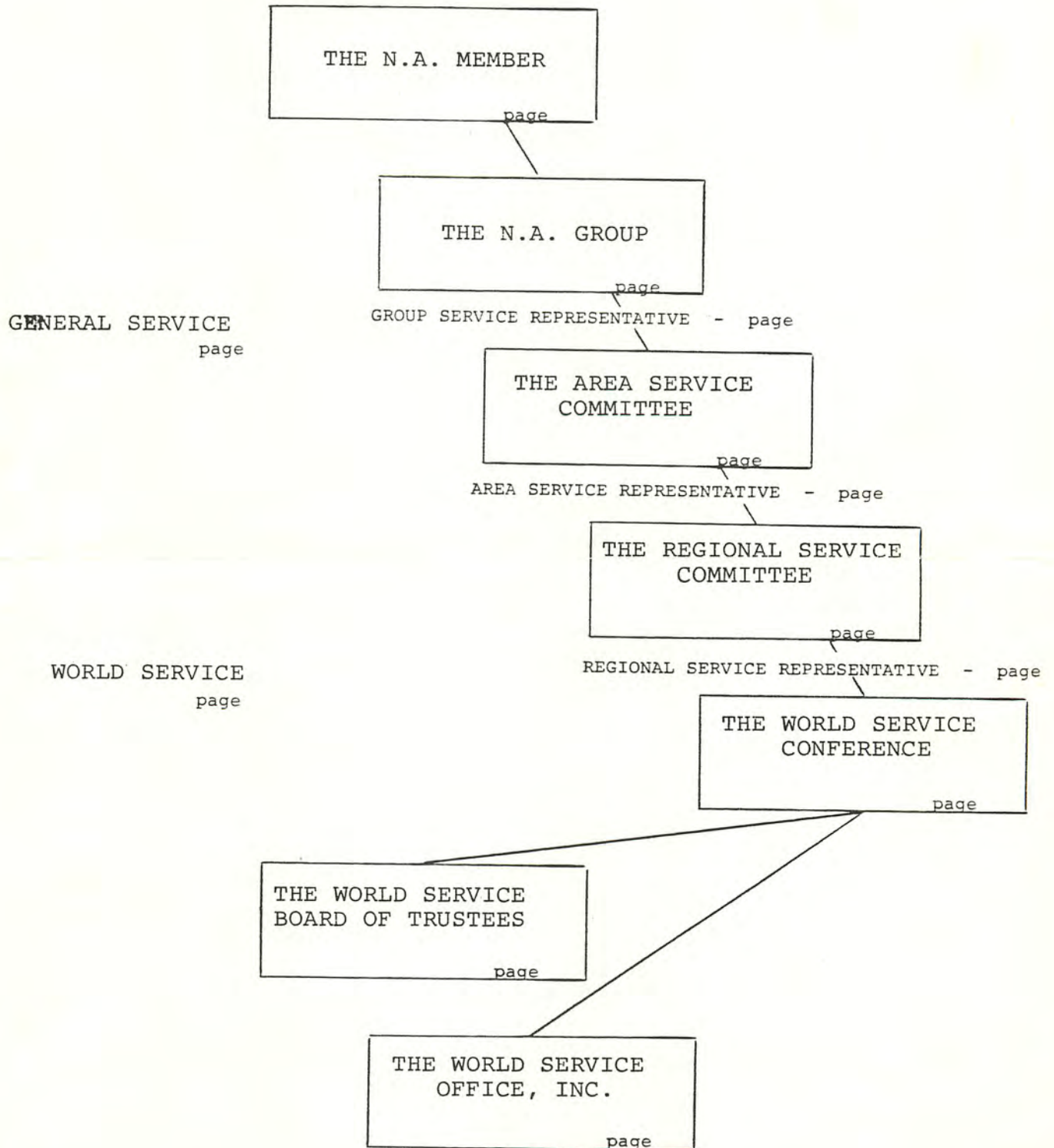

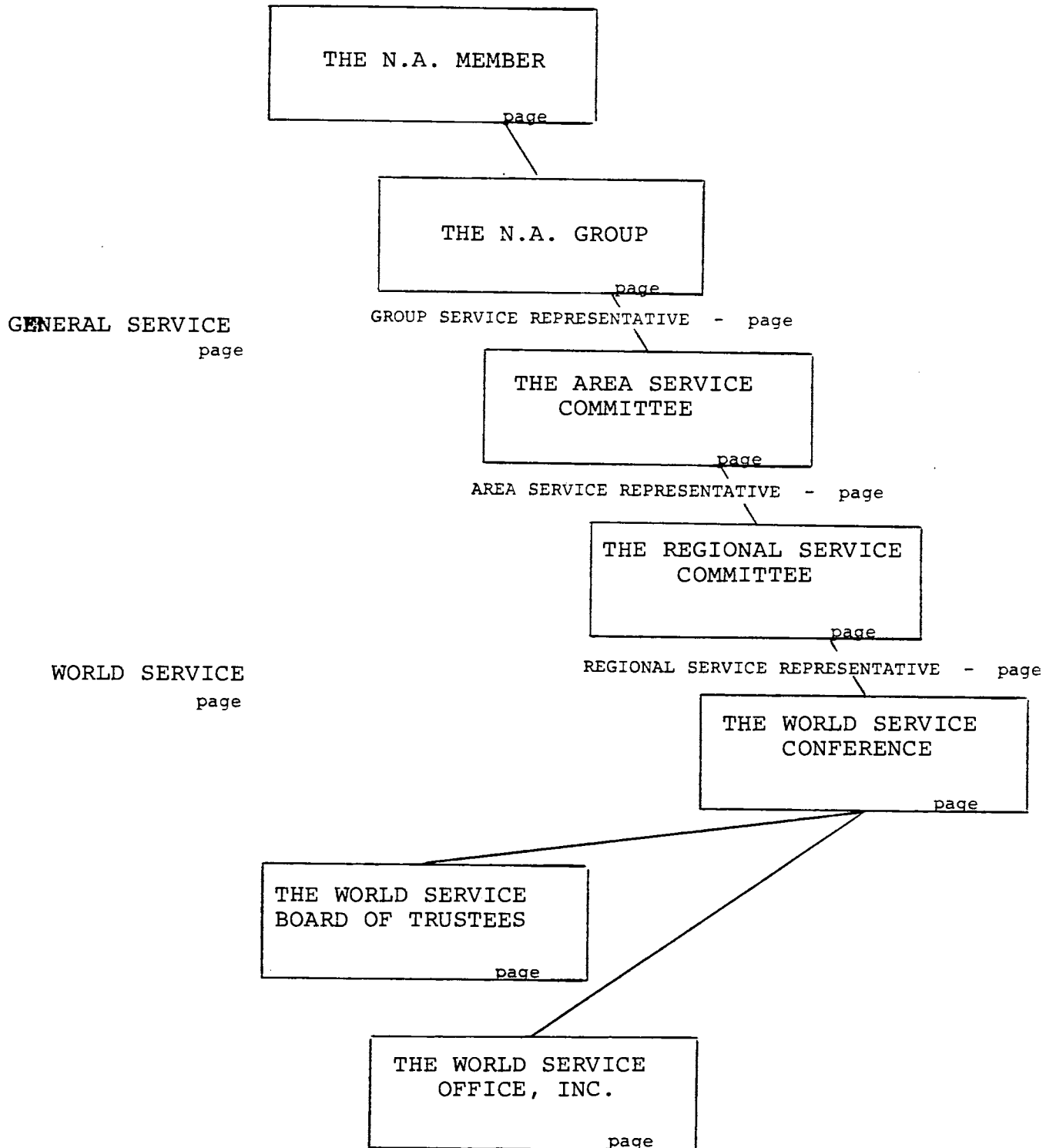

The purpose and function of The service units of Narcotics Anonymous

- ① The primary purpose of an N.A. GROUP is to carry the message to the Addict who still suffers by providing a setting for identification and recovery where an Addict can get help if he or she has a desire to stop using.
- ② The purpose of an AREA SERVICE COMMITTEE is to be supportive to the N.A. Group and its primary purpose by associating the Group with other groups and by helping the Group deal with its day-to-day problems and needs.
- ③ The purpose of a REGIONAL SERVICE COMMITTEE is to be supportive ~~it~~ to its Areas and Groups and their primary purpose by linking together the Areas and Groups within the Region, by helping the Areas and Groups deal with their problems, and by encouraging the growth of the fellowship.
