H. Motion: to begin editing a pamphlet entitled "Resentments Kill" from raw material submitted earlier this year. Motion carried. Les W. will run off 15 copies of this effort.

III. The meeting was closed at 3:00 p.m. with the Lord's Prayer. Our next meeting will be on Sunday, May 27, at 3:00 p.m. at the Rising Sun Clubhouse.
