

WSC LITERATURE COMMITTEE
Minutes of meeting held
June 26, 1979.

- I. Attending: Linda B. Rich B.

II. The meeting was opened at 8:00 p.m. with the Serenity Prayer and the reading of the Twelve Traditions. The minutes of last week's meeting were read and approved.

- A. Bo read the letter to be sent to WLC members which was composed at last week's meeting. Les came with 500 printed copies of the initial WLC letter which will be mailed to 300 N.A. groups around the world. Les also brought envelopes, stationery, and some business cards donated through the printer's error with the N.A. logo. Printing costs totaled \$47.00. Bo's checking with the World Service Conference about funding. Les will print 50 copies each of "Getting Realer" and "For the Newcomer." Minutes of the Literature Committees' meetings will be sent to active areas and to the WSO. A collection was taken for postage.
- B. Bo talked to the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of N.A., Greg Pierce, and asked him to write a long form of the Twelve Traditions with the other trustees.
- C. Linda explained the need for a literature seminar to open up communications between N.A. members and the WLC. Bo and Linda read their notes about a literature format, and we decided that a three hour seminar would best serve our needs. We discussed a date for the seminar, either after the October convention in Wichita for credibility, or before the convention to get the ball rolling. Linda said that a taped answer and question period to find out where people are at in terms of the WLC would be particularly helpful in future plans.
- D. A new viewpoint was expressed concerning this committee's attitude towards mail-outs and efforts to get more recovering addicts involved. Catherine, holding the position of "unless I'm missing the bus, I won't run," suggested a follow-up mail-out in about 6 weeks expressing thanks for the great response and reporting on all the supposed editing being done.
- E. Motion: to not hold the ALC tonight because of lack of time and energy and to discuss the time and location of the next ALC at the next WLC. Motion carried.

III. The meeting was closed at 10:00 p.m. with the Lord's Prayer. The next meeting will be held on Thursday, July 5, at 8:00 p.m. at 201 Copeland Rd. NE Apt K-2 (call 256-1866 for directions).
