Dear Annie and Friends:

I really appreciated our conversation the other night. It helped me to realize the many living problems our members have. Someday I hope our literature can reflect answers we have found together in this program.

I have listed the questions from your letters and will try to answer each of them in terms of what we have talked about here. To begin with we need a registration fee to support the conference. We recommend a fee of ten to twelve dollars would be adequate to fund the conference and perhaps leave enough to help the overall WSC Literature Committee function along the lines we will lay down at the Conference. You should keep careful records as to money spent regarding typesetting, printing and postage and any other general costs regarding the conference. Phone calls, gasoline and other personal expenses should be divided up among your members on a personal contribution basis. Obviously these kinds of expenses could easily get out of hand and it pays to keep it simple.

We recommend that the flyer contain some of the topics to be discussed like newsletters, history, pamphlets, financing the Committee work, chapter titles for the book, timetable for the book, etc. Also include a registration form at the bottom of the flyer. The preregistration money will help with the immediate expenses and you should pick up some bucks at the convention. Bring at least a thousand flyers. I will try to copy our corrected world directory and we recommend that you mail to every group in the world so they will know what is going on and feel welcome even if they can't come. Also mail to the people on the mailing list of the WSC Literature Committee. This should cost about \$75.00 for postage and the printing costs for 500 letters and envelopes.

The rollcall should include the members attending. It lets us know who attends and gets them involved right away. Same with the closing rollcall. I will participate my history of involvement with NA Literature but we might get some support with this from others who will be attending. Maybe the registration form could include a place to put interests and qualifications. I think the way we split into workshops at the WSC will be fine. Literature contributions and presentations should come from those who made them if possible. Contact the other literature committees and ask them if they will take a part of the program.

Why don't you all put on a good bid for the next world convention. I bet you'd get it.
